



2016 American Rally Car Championship

CHAMPIONSHIP SEASON EVENTS ARE: (Scored under OHPRG classes)

- (1)Desert Storm Day 1- April 1- Imperial, CA (HQ- Blythe, CA) plus the 2015 Championship Invitational Event
- (2)Desert Storm Day 2 – April 2- Ehrenburg, AZ (HQ- Blythe, CA) plus the 2015 Championship Invitational Event
- (3)Sonora Rally (Sonora, Mexico) – April 3-7 to piggyback with Desert Storm Rally and a special entry price.
- (3)Pacific NW Rally – TBD on date in Washington State
- (4 and 5)Rally Utah or Rally Nevada – St. George, UT or Mesquite, NV. August 5/6
- (6) Seed 9 Rally – Jean, NV. Nov 5

NOTE: We are still in negotiations with other events that may come on board during the season.

CLASSES

The OHPRG will recognize a National and Regional Champion in the following categories:

Rally-Open	Rally-G5
Rally-Open Limited	Rally-GT
Rally-SP	Rally-Production
Rally-G2	National 4WD
	National 2WD

DIVISIONS

A Driver and Co-Driver champion will be established in each class. There is no distinguished region for these championships.

POINTS

Points will be awarded on the following positions

1 st – 23 points	7 – 6 points
2 nd – 18 points	8 - 4 points
3 th – 15 points	9 - 2 points
4 th – 12 points	10 – last place- 1 point
5 – 10 points	Started – 1 point
6 - 8 points	

Championship points will be calculated by multiplying the event finish points (in class) by the coefficient for the event –e.g., 3rd place at a Coefficient 2 rally will earn 30 championship points or Coefficient 3 rally will earn 45 championship points.

LICENSES

OHPRG license is \$75.00's for competitors (national and regional) for 2016. OHPRG will be a SFI member for safety and technical purposes. The sanction body for American Rally Car Championship

Why? This is to offset administrative expenses and Participant & Accident insurance for organizations and volunteers.

You go to www.ohprg.com to sign up and pay for your license.

Unlicensed competitors are asked to submit a competition resume to OHPRG at least two weeks in advance of an event for review of experience. Competitors with less than 9 coefficients of experience or equivalent will be limited to entering in the following classes: Rally Open Limited, Rally-GP2, and Rally-Production.

NATIONAL ENTRIES

OHPRG encourages national teams to run in this championship by running in these specified classes that will be National 4WD and National 2WD. So it's simple and easy to score.

National entries will be able to win in a regional event overall or place as their finish times would indicate. However, they will NOT take regional points away from other competitors since they have their own classes.

We want to encourage this championship for non-national teams to be able to go to the invited year-end championship event to have a chance to be a part of the monetary prizes as well as winning a championship trophy. The event will be in the following year to allow all event scores are used to determine who will be invited to the championship event national and regional.

CHALLENGE INVITATIONAL (YEAR-END) CHAMPIONSHIP

The end of the year will feature a championship event where winners of the regional championships for regional and national categories will compete to determine the American Rally Car Champion(s) in the various classes. Each class champion will be invited to the Challenge Year-End Championship depending upon how many are registered for each class category. Ex.: Rally -Grp 2 should have over 15 registered for that category then 8 will be invited.

The event has yet to be selected, and will be in early 2017 as the invitational event. This event will determine the champions for 2016 and at the same time award points for the 2017 season.
